Meeting with DFID

A meeting with the representatives of DFID was held under the chairmanship of Chairman P&D Board on June 23rd, 2015 at P&D Department. The purpose was to discuss the current status of PPP Projects and earmark the potential areas for DFID funding program. Chairman briefed the delegates about ongoing and pipeline PPP projects and apprised that during last year three projects have been successfully awarded to private parties including foreign investors. He also spoke about various initiatives of Government of the Punjab taken towards urban development collaboration with international organizations like World Bank, ADB and Chinese investors and emphasized over sector wise priority areas which needs to be focused including establishment of skilled development authority, water,

infrastructure development and capacity building of government departments. Chairman was pleased to share the proposal of Public Private Dialogue Cell especially focused to enhance economic growth and development in the region.

Member (PPP/E), P&D Board informed the delegation about the upcoming projects including Development of Business Incubation Center in Lahore, Diagnostic Centers in Hospital, Clusters Development Centers and PPP model schools in education sector.

Southern Loop of LRR is 30.4 Km long starting from Sui Gas Town to Gujjar Pura, Multan Road, Lahore.

3-lanes dual carriageway. 5 Kms service roads along side interchanges.

PNoy Drives through 1st PPP Road Project

President Benigno Aquino III on Friday led the opening of the Muntinlupa-Cavite Expressway (MCX), the first public private partnership road project to be inaugurated under his five-year-old administration.

Riding a white SUV, Aquino became the first person to drive through the MCX, also known as the Daang Hari-South Luzon Expressway (SLEX) Link Road Project.

The road will be open to the public and will be fully operational by 2 p.m. Friday. The four-kilometer, four lane toll road passes through the New Bilibid Prison reservation to link Bacoor, Cavite to the SLEX.

The MCX is expected to decongest traffic in Cavite, Las Piñas and Muntinlupa, and cut travel time from Daang Hari to the Alabang Interchange to 45 minutes on average.
