

Training on Asian Development Bank Loan and Grant Disbursement Procedures at Public Private Partnership (PPP) Cell

Government of Punjab has signed a five years program titled as “Enhancing Public Private Partnership in Punjab” with Asian Development Bank (ADB). This program will supplement Government's allocation for Viability Gap Fund (VGF) and Project Development Facility (PDF). Under this program, ADB will provide USD 100 million loan. Program also consists of an additional USD 23.6 million Department for International Development (DFID) grant administrated through ADB.

Recently, ADB organized a training session titled as 'ADB Loan and Grant Disbursement Procedures' with representatives from Finance Department, External Capital Assistance (ECA) wing, Planning & Development Department and PPP Cell on 4th and 5th July, 2018. Training was facilitated by Mr. Babar T. Khan, Unit Head Disbursement (ADB). The objective of this two days training was to develop understanding of ADB loan disbursement policies, guidelines and procedures.
