

Lecture on Public Private Partnerships at National Management College

Member (PPP/ Head of PPP Cell), Mr. Agha Waqar Javed was invited by National School of Public Policy, Senior Management Wing to deliver lecture to 24th Senior Management Course on '**Public Private Partnerships**'. The session was attended by senior BS-19 officers from Pakistan Administrative Service (PAS), Police Service of Pakistan, Secretariat Group, Pakistan Audit and Accounts Service, Foreign Service of Pakistan, Commerce & Trade Group, Inland Revenue Service, Pakistan Customs Service, Railways Group, Ex-Cadre and Provincial Services.

Mr. Javed gave a detailed presentation about Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) highlighting the PPP concept, legal framework, success stories and challenges. He also shed light on People's first PPPs and equitable risk allocation under PPP arrangement. Member (PPP) further informed that a number of projects worth PKR 108.8 billion have been awarded to private investors (both foreign and local) whereas 38 projects across various sectors envisaging an estimated investment of PKR 220 billion are in the pipeline. He informed that with projects already awarded in infrastructure, transport, health, food, forestry, and housing sectors, PPP Cell is now structuring sustainable and bankable transactions in livestock, tourism and recreational sectors as well. The presentation was followed by a detailed Q&A session.
